

CBC Kids Discipline Plan

- Teachers at the beginning of each class should remind the children of these four rules
 - Respect yourself and others
 - Listen and obey your teachers
 - No hurts, verbal or physical
 - Have fun!
- Discipline for not listening and obeying
 - Strike 1: Teacher gently exhorts child to not continue to disobey
 - Strike 2: Teacher gives another exhortation
 - Strike 3: Teacher should alert the Kids Min Coordinator to talk to the child and potentially call their parents
- Discipline for verbal hurt (name calling, bullying, insults, etc.)
 - Strike 1: Teacher gently exhorts child to not continue to disobey
 - Strike 2: Teacher gives another exhortation
 - Strike 3: Teacher should alert the Kids Min Coordinator to talk to the child and potentially call their parents
- Discipline for physical hurts
 - Teacher should gently exhort child if they hit someone by mistake
 - Teacher should alert the Kids Min Coordinator to talk to the child and potentially call their parents if they hit someone in anger
- Protection against partiality in discipline
 - Teachers must see the action that is needing of discipline or it must be seen by two or more people in the classroom, especially if a removal is involved
